## **Budget Estimate.**

Precept Request. 2021/22 Precept request will be for £20,000. This is due to the increase in occupied dwellings within the Parish as per the 2021 Register of Electors. Since the 2020 Register of Electors which showed 782 dwellings occupied the 2021 Register of Electors now shows that 853 dwellings are now occupied. This is an increase of 71 additional dwellings occupied this year. These figures do not included empty dwellings which will still require the owners to pay Council Tax. Dwellings that have been occupied since the Register of Electors was completed are not included in these figures and the number will possibly increase. The indicative tax base for 2020/21 (based on 98.25% collection rate adjusted for the impact of localisation of council tax support) is £915.50. The indicative provision funding allocation is £348

VAT REFUND 2010/21 Expected refund as of 21.01.2021 - £6,459.39 (This may show some increase by the end of the financial year but only slightly).

<u>FUNDING</u> – We received a sum of £6,000 from the William Hall Trust for funding to have a seating area within the Play Area. With agreement from the William Hall Trust this money was used to fund the play area equipment. It is necessary that this amount is found from 2021/22 finances to build the seating area.

**GRANT APPLICATION** – The Banks Group have indicated that they would look favourably on a grant application up to the value of £5,000

REPAIR WORK TO PLAY AREA FENCE – It may be necessary to replace the fence between the Play Area and Orchard House. It may be prudent to wait and see what the new owners do with the garden and if they remove the ivy which is holding the fence together.
