1) APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE -Mr. D. Hadfield, Mrs. P. Deepak, Borough Councillors Mr A Sherris and Mr. D. Fagan

2) DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

JB & AA declared a non-prejudicial interest as a member of Kirklevington Action Group (KAG). **JB** declared a non-prejudicial interest as Treasurer of Kirklevington Memorial Hall. **AA** declared a non-prejudicial interest as Chairman of Kirklevington Memorial Hall. **JB** showed a non-prejudicial interest as a close neighbour of planning application 21/0156/FULt.

3) MINUTES OF THE LAST PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

4) MATTERS ARISING MINUTES

28.06.21 - 6) WARD BOUNDARY CHANGE PROPOSALS

The **PC** reported that a decision was expected by the beginning of September but no further information has been received to date. The response sent to the Boundary Commission by Mr. Richard Hodgson had been circulated to all Parish Councillors and it was agreed that his comments were poiniant. **JB** suggested to the meeting that a Freedom of Information request be submitted to the **LGBCE** for clarification re many issues. **JB** and the **PC** would be in discussion with Mr. Hodgson and update him on the Parish Council's views and responses.

5) QUESTIONNAIRE

NDB updated the meeting on the progress so far. Work now needs to be made into looking at the details of the responses received which would be carried out together with **DH**. Responses had been interesting but not surprising in many cases and **NDB** looked forward to sharing the responses received once processed.

6) PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY ISSUES

- AA had circulated to members a proposal re the work that is needed to update and repair the PROW around the school and in particular the southern section. The need to install drainage from the school field also needs to be put in pace to allow for water to drain from the school site. This has been discussed with Mark Green of Story Homes. A. Smuk of SBC has already indicated to Mark Green that it is their responsibility to sort this problem out. The bottom section of school field's drains run down towards the corner of the Story site. The top section of the school site's water drains toward Squirrels Leap and the drainage system at this point. JB suggested that this is a matter that should also be taken up by the School Academy Trust together with SBC. The PC to contact the Head of School at Kirklevington Primary School and update her of the issues.
- Wooden Fence The wooden fence that is in place around the southern edge of the school field and on the
 northern edge of the PROW is now in need of being removed. The PC to contact the Head of School at
 Kirklevington Primary School to let her know the of the condition of the fence and the need for it to be removed.
 Several members of the Parish Council indicated that they would be willing to help with the removal of the fence
 and the PC was ask to indicated this to the Head of School.

7) PLANNING

a) PLANNING UPDATE

i) Story Development

NDB updated the meeting of a meeting that he had held between himself and Mark Green of Story Homes
(details of meeting had been circulated to all members prior to meeting). NDB was able to confirm that the car
park would be ready for opening very shortly and he confirmed that he had made it very clear that signage

needed to be put in place to make sure that all drivers exit the car park to the right with a direct route to the A67 thus avoiding any issues of drivers driving down Pump Lane in the wrong direction.

ii) Banks/Taylor Wimpey - 21/0156/FUL

- NDB reported to the meeting that no further information has been received to date re this application.
- Unknown outcome from the extensive Archeological survey that had been conducted.
- Reports have been received that neither Story Homes or the Tate family have been contacted to date by Banks/Taylor Wimpey re the suggested alternative route for all site vehicles to access the A67 and clarification of this needs to be ascertained.
- No new documents have been placed on the SBC planning portal re this application or for the already approved 16/3035/OUT application.
- We still await information re planning application no. 21/0156/FUL for 97 dwellings and no date has been set for this to go before SBC's Planning Committee.

iii) Theakstons

Notice has been served that there is to be a **Public Enquiry to be held 15th – 19th November, 2021** re the proposed development for 300 dwellings on the Theakston site. Planning Application **18/0910/OUT** for 300 dwellings has already been refused by SBC Planning Committee which the Parish Council support. Theakstons already have permission for 100 dwellings on this site – Planning application no.**16/1959/OUT**. The access on to this site from the A67 still remains an extreme concern to the Parish Council and all it's residents and drivers who use this road to access and return from the A19 on a daily basis together with the traffic generated by residents of Kirklevington village and surrounding areas. Further details expected shortly.

c) External Audit 2020/21

The **PC** reported that the external auditors Mazars LLP had signed off the 2020/21 accounts. A notice has also been placed on the Parish Council notice board to give notice of conclusion of the audit procedures.

12) VILLAGE ISSUES

i) Service Bus

Under the conditions of the Story Homes planning agreement a condition was that following the occupation of the 60th dwelling a service bus should be provided for a period of 5 years. The **PC** was requested to contact Jonathan Kibble of SBC to question as to when the process of obtaining a service bus would start. It was felt that this should not be left until the last minute when the 60th dwelling is actually occupied.

ii) Lights for Christmas Tree

The **PC** drew to the meetings attention that she had been approached by SBC asking if we still needed to have lights put on our Christmas Tree in the Play Area together with protective fencing. All present confirmed that they still wanted them. The **PC** also drew to the meetings attention that, at some time in the future, there will almost certainly be a need to purchase new lights. All present agreed that they would look favourably to such a purchase in the future.

iii) Car Fire - Castle Leavington

NDB drew to the meetings attention that there had been a car that was on fire down Castle Levington Road which had been identified by a resident and the fire service called.

iv) Welcome to new Vicar

JB reported that she had represented the Parish Council at the Collation and Installation of the Rev. Darren Moore who is now our new vicar at Kirklevington together with Yarm and Worsall. **JB** had welcomed Rev. Moore on our behalf.

iv) Car Park - Story Site

NDB was able to report to the meeting the the new car park at the Story site was in the process of being opened. It is hoped that drivers using both the Village Hall and the Primary School will now use this rather than park on Forest Lane and surrounding roads which will ease congestion.

13) ROAD SAFETY MATTERS

Speeding cars still remain an issue along Forest Lane. The Parish Council continue to look at ideas to stop this inconsiderate behaviour by many drivers and in particular those using the route as a 'rat run' to the A67 thus avoiding Green Lane.
